Special Accolade of the Month

HCL Foundation Sports Scholar and badminton prodigy, 18-year old Jerlin Anika, has become the first woman Deaflympian to receive the Arjuna Award, India's second highest sports honour.

Jerlin clinched three gold medals at the 24th Summer Deaflympics held in Brazil this year. She also won six gold medals at the Asia Pacific Deaf Badminton Championship held in Thailand. Basis her numerous laurels over the last few years, she was selected for the prestigious Arjuna Award which is the 2nd highest sporting award in India awarded by the honourable President of India.

She was identified as a Sports Scholar through the Sports for Change initiative based on her achievements in badminton. Since then, HCL Foundation has supported Jerlin for her nutrition, sports equipment and travel needs.

Dr. Nidhi Pundhir, Vice President, Global CSR, HCLTech motivated the partners and HCL Foundation Team to bring the spirit of working together for a collective humanitarian cause.

















Highlights of the Month

Recognized for efforts towards contributing to Clean Ganga Mission

At the Ganga Utsav 2022, HCL Foundation was felicitated for its support to Clean Ganga Fund in the presence of Shri Gajendra Singh Shekhawat, Hon'ble Minister of Jal Shakti, Gol, and Shri G. Asok Kumar, Director General, NMCG. Under HCL Harit (the green initiative) programme, HCL Foundation has partnered with NMCG and INTACH towards rejuvenation of Ganga catchment in the mid Himalayan ranges of Uttarakhand and is working on conservation of Alakhnanda catchment through Rudraksh and associated species plantation. Till date, we have successfully planted 10,000+ saplings across 45+ acres of area.

In addition to our work in Uttarakhand, we are also contributing to increasing the green cover and ground water recharge in Gautam Buddh Nagar and Lucknow districts through our afforestation and water conservation projects in Yamuna, Hindon and Gomti rivers basins. In these 2 districts, we have successfully planted 4.5+ lakhs saplings across 100+ acres of land and rejuvenated 52+ waterbodies that has resulted in recharge of ~9.04 bn liters of water. We have also completed rejuvenation and beautification of 6 ponds in Samuday intervention gram panchayats of Hardoi in Uttar Pradesh, and will initiate work on 12 more ponds in the coming days.

HCL Grant completed the 4th stage of 'Field Audit Visit' and consolidated the field level due diligence in the presence of Ms. Roshni Nadar Malhotra, Chairperson HCLTech; & Dr Nidhi Pundhir, Vice President, Global CSR; to select the top 10 NGOs under each category – Environment, Health & Education.

In the process to identify the best NGO for receiving the HCL Grant, the eminent experts travelled over 1,00,000 kilometers to visit 51 NGOs to understand their work and present their cases for the Sub Jury round. More than 3,300 hours have been invested in this stage of the selection process.

Promoting ecofriendly and cost effective way to develop colours, a workshop on preparation of Natural colors was organized on November 13, 2022. The workshop was attended by children from the nearby community who learned the traditional methods to develop natural colors from tree leaves and flowers.



A nest making workshop organized on November 18, 2022 by joined efforts of GMTT, Eco roots and HCL Foundation. The workshop was based on training the participants to develop nest from the waste materials such as dry leaves and bushes for birds.



A seed ball and seed paper workshop organized by GMTT and HCL Foundation on November 2, 2022. 40 community leaders participated in the new method recycling products and were sensitized about urban afforestation.

Responsible Kite Flying Campaign

As part of Responsible Kite Flying project, ARRT in collaboration with HCL foundation conducted multiple Manjha awareness/cleanup events with a focus on educating the public, especially school children about the issue. Alternate toys and games were used as tools to educate them about safer kite thread alternatives. Removing Manjha from the environment is essential to mitigate the threat to birds and keep the environment safe for urban wildlife. To generate targeted awareness for maximum impact, ARRT built a web application showing each Manjha rescue that allows the user to view Manjha hotspots near school locations in Bengaluru. Through HCL partnership, ARRT was able to help 1,832 urban wild animals across 72 species over the last five months.



World Fisheries Day Celebration

The students of Composite School, Kulesera celebrated World Fisheries Day on November 21, 2022. Gorakhpur Environmental Action Group (GEAG) in partnership with HCL Foundation organized a workshop and awareness programme to highlight the importance of conserving fisheries and water life.

The students learned about protecting their nearby waterbodies from waste dump, plastic pollution, and other concerning issues.

MoU Extension Between Banaskantha and HCL Foundation

On November 7, 2022, HCL Foundation signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Banaskantha District Cooperative Milk Producers' Union Limited to boost the income of dairy farmers under its flagship programme, HCL Samuday. This partnership will benefit around 25,000 dairy farmers across 11 blocks of Hardoi, Uttar Pradesh. Furthermore, the setting up of a new Bulk Milk Chilling Unit was also announced, which will have a capacity of 1 lakh litre of milk per day.

The MoU was exchanged in the presence of Mr. G S Priyadarshi (IAS), Commissioner, Rural Development; Brigadier Vinod Bajiya, Executive Director, Banas Dairy; Mr Alok Varma, Project Director, HCL Samuday (HCL Foundation); and Mr. Kamraj R. Chaudhary, Chief Operating Officer, Banas Dairy. The dignitaries also felicitated secretaries of 5 village-level Dairy Farmer Associations for their tremendous contribution to the sector.



The initial partnership (started in 2019) between HCL Foundation & Banas Dairy has brought about momentous progress in the lives of dairy farmers in Hardoi. During this period, approximately 12,000 farmers got a fair and reliable source of income, increased their savings, and learned innovative processes of dairy farming.

The renewed alliance look forward to touching higher milestones while promoting sustainable and equitable dairy practices.

Newborn Care Week was celebrated from November 15-21, 2022. Different types of awareness activity in the community were organized to raise awareness about the importance of newborn care for child survival and development.



Awareness sessions were organized on communicable and non-communicable diseases in the communities we serve. During these sessions screening tools were used and videos were shown through door to door visit for IPC sessions. Beneficiaries were given proper information about various topics and government services available, to help them avail these services.



Three days SHG Books of record training conducted with support of HCL Foundation in Sarojini Nagar, Lucknow by Aawahan. 35 SHG members participated in the training. The Presidents or Secretaries of the SHG groups attended the training to learn about maintaining books of record.

In the BIC at Bangalore we have trained 650+ army veterans, mentored 450+ protegés and incubated 100+ entrepreneurs since inception. Total investment on these business units is approximately 8.5cr. Furthermore, 250+ jobs are created from these establishments.

Under the Skill Development vertical of HCL Uday, a for new age technology lab has been setup at Cummins Women's College, Nagpur. With this initiative we are making the youth ready for new age technology job market in Artificial Intelligence (AI), Machine Learning (ML) and Internet of Things.

HCLTechies shall be volunteering to conduct knowledge sharing sessions with students. Training of Teachers will also be conducted to apprise them of the given technologies.

World Toilet Day was celebrated on November 19, 2022 to sensitize students on importance of Safely Managed Sanitation.

WASH Awareness sessions organized in 9 Govt. High Schools at Hyderabad. 850+ students were sensitized on importance of proper hand wash, cleanliness, proper WASH behaviour, menstrual hygiene, proper toilet usage, solid waste management and sustainable maintenance of WASH infrastructure.

Towards increasing employability among youth job seekers, HCL Foundation has been imparting Skill Development training to youth in various trades like Fitter, Solar Technician, BPO, Retail Sales Executive, General Duty Assistant, Pharmacy Assistant and much more. Apart from these trades, youth also been trained in Soft Skills & Life Skills. In addition. Advance JAVA Training programme is provided to Engineering Graduates. Around 260 youth have been under training presently. Trained candidates will be supported with suitable employment opportunities.

Clean Noida



4 Ponds Successfully Rejuvenated in Noida

Promoting integrated solid and liquid waste management under Clean NOIDA, 4 ponds across the city have been successfully rejuvenated. This was made possible with the support of local community members and Sukriti Social Foundation.

The process involved assessment of water samples, surface cleaning, dewatering, desilting, and filtration. As a result, about 40 tonnes of solid waste and 10 tonnes of silt were removed from these water bodies, which will help increase the groundwater table in the long run.



HCLTech Poland have been working with the Krakow Food Bank for over a year now and looking at ways to further expand our cooperation with the hope that more organizations from Crocow will encourage their employees to take up voluntary work. We were also delighted to able to make a donation to subsidize the costs for two new vans financed by the Nationals Funds for Environmental Protection and Water Management, foodbank have been able to increase food collection from stores and provide more food aid to partner organisations that look after people in need.

Global CSR



Pol Donations helped launch a new partnership with Girl Up, a leadership development initiative by the United Nations Foundation. Founded in 2010 with the goal of advancing gender equality and justice, Girl Up operates in 130 countries and all 50 U.S. states. Working with Girl Up, HCLTech will help to empower young women and create greater education and employment opportunities through programs such as a STEM for Social Good Bootcamp with the theme of "Safe Cities Powered by Technology," Innovation Lab, Mentorship Program and a multi-day Global Leadership Summit.



Through a long-term CSR partnership with Feeding America, Pol donations and continued dedication to volunteerism are helping to fight food insecurity in local communities year-round. As the largest hunger-relief organization in the U.S., Feeding America provided 6.6 billion meals and rescued 4.7 billion pounds of food waste in 2021.



One Tree Planted works to give back to the environment, create a healthier climate, protect biodiversity and help reforestation effort around the world. Pol donations allowed HCLTech to commit to planting 100,000 trees in the Americas—including the U.S., Canada, Mexico and Brazil—and continue organizing restoration and planting volunteer opportunities in local communities.



HCL Foundation was recently represented at UNESCO's World Conference on Early Childhood Care and Education (WCECCE) which took place in Tashkent from 14-16 November 2022 by its ECCD lead, **Dr. Neelima Chopra, PhD.** The conference reaffirmed the right of every child to quality care and education from birth.

The key takeaway from the Conference is the need to build a diverse workforce for ECCE and invest in building their competency. Currently, lower income and lack of professionalism result in attrition of educators.

HCL Foundation's work in Early Childhood Care and Education is aligned with the global framework and understanding that inclusive and quality ECE is every child's right.



On November 16, 2022, **Meha Tiwari** represented HCL Foundation as a speaker at a Girl Up STEM for Social Good Bootcamp on Safe Cities powered by Technology. The panel was about greater representation for Women in STEM fields and how it can lead to social change and gender equality. The bootcamp was attended by girls and women between the ages 13 to 24 in India and globally.
