Highlights of the Month

HCL Foundation participates in the UN 2023 Water Conference

HCL Foundation participated in the historic UN 2023 Water Conference held in New York, USA from March 22-24, 2023, as part of its official side-events agenda, in a session that saw participation from cross-sectional, multi-stakeholder groups united for water action.

The UN 2023 Water Conference underscores the significance of Water for Sustainable Development and provided a platform to bring in sustainable solutions from across the world towards water conservation.

The side-event was organized by HCL Foundation in collaboration with The Nature Conservancy, Ashoka Trust for Research in Ecology and the Environment, Indian Institute for Human Settlements, Gorakhpur Environmental Action Group and panelists from India Water Foundation and World Bank.

The discussion centered around case studies and success stories on the interlinkage of terrestrial aquatic ecosystem rejuvenation, native biodiversity, climate and community resilience — and how they are sustained and scaled by convergent community action and public-private partnerships.

Vaccination for Dogs

HCL Foundation with the support of Blue Cross of India conducted a mass vaccination drive for community-owned and free-roaming dogs in Kannagi Nagar, Chennai. More than 300 dog owners in the community actively participated and rendered support to the mass vaccination drive. 930+ dogs were administered with a single dose of a 9 in 1 vaccine that boosts the immunity of dogs against 5 viral and 4 bacterial diseases that are often fatal to the dogs. Few dogs that were vaccinated were also marked with vegetable-based dye on their nape post-vaccination for identification and monitoring.



World Sparrow Day

To mark the World Sparrow Day, HCL Foundation under our flagship programme HCL Harit in partnership with Eco Roots Foundation organized nest making workshops at multiple locations in Lucknow. The workshop was organized to create awareness on sparrows, the threats they face and steps one can take to conserve them. A total of 26 students and 27 HCLTechies volunteered and created 30+ bird nests. These nests will be placed in natural spaces within close vicinity to create an eco-friendly environment.



First batch of Wild Champs Winners Announced

Wild Champs is an Environment Education initiative of HCL Foundation and Centre for Wildlife Studies (CWS) aiming to empower students around wildlife reserves to come up with nature based solutions for local environmental and wildlife conservation issues. Recently, we announced the Wild Champs. A total of 118 students from 16 schools around Anamalai Tiger reserve, Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu took part in the event and were awarded by Anamalai Block Education Officer (BEO). Students also had the opportunity to present and discuss their work with fellow students and teachers.

5th National Para Badminton Championship 2022–23 at Lucknow

HCL Grant-supported programme participants were selected to represent the state of Karnataka in the 5th National Para Badminton Championship 2022-23 at Lucknow. The women's team comprising of 7 players won two gold, two silver and one bronze medal in the championship. The participants are from The Association of People with Disabilities (APD) who were the Health category HCL Grant Recipient in the year 2022.



International Women's Day Celebration

Stressing upon the need to provide safe and secure environment for women at home, work and public places, She hope Society for Women Entrepreneur in collaboration with HCL Foundation and the District Administration Ganderbal, celebrated International Women' Day on 8th March 2023. The society is HCL Grant 2019 edition winners, under the Health Category.

Education for Children with Visual Impairment

With the Government administration support, Model District Level Education Centre (DLEC) established in Udaipur has been upscaled to all the other blocks of the district and dedicated teachers have been allocated by the government for each DLEC ensuring regular support and education for Children with Visual Impairment in Kotra, Jhadol and Udaipur blocks of Udaipur district in Rajasthan.

Flowering the Future

Rakesh Kumar Maurya (Kinhouti, Sandila), a farmer associated with HCL Samuday, was awarded for his contributions by Mr. Baldev Singh Aulakh, Honorable Minister of State in the Ministry of Agricultural Education and Agricultural Research, Uttar Pradesh under the Floriculture Mission of CSIR-NBRI (National Botanical Research Institute), Lucknow. Rakesh shared his experience and the joint contribution of HCL Foundation and NBRI in assisting farmers with promoting good agricultural practices. This was during the 2-day Annual Flower Festival organized by NBRI wherein more than 100 farmers of our project area and 10 team members participated. A collaborative partnership with NBRI is being ensured for promotion of floriculture in the region.



An Attempt to Eradicate TB

HCL Samuday marked World Tuberculosis Day on 24th March by counselling and sensitizing the community regarding risk factors, symptomatology and treatment of Tuberculosis across 13 Health and Wellness Centers through telemedicine facility and 11 Community Health Centers through Mobile Health Clinics. IEC pamphlets were also distributed to convey the message. 1,060 programme participants beneficiaries were counselled on Tuberculosis & identifying TB markers and symptoms.



Artificial Insemination Technician cum Para Vet Training and Certification

Under dairy development project of HCL Samuday, 19 volunteers from the project area went to Uttrakhand Livestock Development Board, Pashulok, Rishikesh for a 45-day AI Technician cum Para Vet training program. These 19 volunteers are now certified to work as an AI Technician cum Para Vet and serve the dairy farmers in the region. They will work as village level service provider with our veterinary team and support them on various field activities like mobilizing farmers for Animals Preventive Health Camps and Fertility Improvement Camps.



Promoting Young Minds in Science

National Science Day was celebrated on 28th February in various primary and composite schools of Hardoi to create awareness about the contribution and importance of science in education and society. Quiz and project model exhibitions based on science were organized for the occasion, and a total of 2,200 students participated enthusiastically. 150 students won science kits along with experiment books which will go a long way in quenching the inquisitiveness among these small geniuses.





Solid Waste Management Initiated in 7 new Nagar Panchayats/Palikas

HCL Foundation, under its flagship programme HCL Samuday, has partnered with Indo-Global Social Service Society (IGSSS) for a new project aimed at tackling solid waste management issues in seven nagar panchayats (palikas) of Hardoi district in Uttar Pradesh. The project will involve mass awareness campaigns aimed at educating residents on the various aspects of SWM, including waste segregation, collection, transportation, and disposal. It will ensure the active involvement of community members, Nagar Palika/Panchayat members, and related government departments to effectively implement SWM practices. The project will also promote the use of eco-friendly products, discourage the use of single-use plastics, and support the implementation of a sustainable waste management system.



Samuday at AIC FEMPRENEUR

On 29th March 2023, 4 team members from HCL Samuday and 9 female artisans who are running product/services based enterprises attended the AIC-FEMPRENEUR event organized by Shiv Nadar (Institute of Eminence deemed to be) University and Atal Incubation Centre (AIC) at SNU Campus, Dadri, Greater Noida. The occasion provided female entrepreneurs supported by HCL Samuday an opportunity to be among other Women Champions and celebrate the enterprising spirit of women. Products handmade by rural women artisans under HCL Samuday's handicraft project were also highlighted through an exhibition during this event.



Medical Health Camp for Sanitation Workers

This month, screening and counselling of 513 sanitation workers as part of a medical health camp was completed across 5 Urban Local Bodies (Nagar Panchayats and Palika) in Hardoi. The idea was to help them improve their physical and mental well-being. Complimentary counseling was given, medical evaluations were done, and suitable medications were prescribed. Those who needed specialized treatment were referred to a higher facility.


