existence. Power of One is the medium for inspiring people to volunteer and/or join the payroll-giving program. It is premised on the idea that 1 hour, 1 day or 1 week of community service and a voluntary contribution of ₹ 1 per day can make a huge difference in people's lives and can go a long way in making a significant impact in the society.
