## Education

### Meeting of Constituent Committee on Digital Literacy and Computational Thinking

Post the successful completion of 'Digital Literacy, Coding and Computational Thinking' intervention under Samuday in Hardoi, Uttar Pradesh, Director General School Education, Government of UP has issued an order to form a committee to develop Computer Curriculum and Syllabus for the state. The members constitute Government Dept. Officials along with representatives from Samuday team. The committee had their first successful meeting in June in Lucknow; with more meetings are scheduled for the next month.



## Health

### Nutrition Camps Initiated in Bakshi Ka Taalaab, Lucknow

Samuday has collaborated with the district administration of Lucknow in an endeavor to replicate their flagship 'Home-Based Nutrition Camps' intervention. The project was initiated in the Bakshi Ka Talab block, a rural block in Lucknow district. The District Commissioner for Rural Development Smt. Dr. Roshan Jacob, inaugurated the medical screening in Kathwara Gram Panchayat of BKT block and appreciated the work being done by HCL Foundation in Hardoi district. Chief Development Officer – Ms. Riya Kejriwal, and Sub- Divisional Magistrate Mrs. Pragya Pandey were also present on the occasion, along with Mr. Yogesh Kumar – Group Operations Head, Samuday. In the same event, 50 children were medically screened by a doctor for medical complications along with malnutrition.



### International Yoga Day

The International Day of Yoga was celebrated across Samuday's Primary Health Centers in the geography with doctors, health staff and community members. The event was aimed to cultivate a culture of physical activeness to reduce diseases and a balanced way of leading day-to-day life.

## HCLFoundation & Tata STRIVE Signed an MoU for Skill Development of Rural Youth

HCLFoundation & Tata STRIVE signed an MoU to equip youths with relevant skills through a skill development programme. As a result of this partnership the re-establishment of Skilling Centre (Yuva Kaushal Extension Centre) at the Government Industrial Training Institute Hardoi has been done with the support of the Training & Skill Development Department, GoUP. The trades in which these youths will be trained are Assistant Electrician, Solar PV Technician & RAC Technician. The MoU was exchanged by Mr. Alok Varma, Project Director – Samuday & Clean Noida and Ms. Anita Rajan, CEO, Tata STRIVE.



## Quarterly Dairy Associations' Review

A review meeting was organized by Samuday on 17-18 June to analyze the progress of the 140 dairy federations operational across 5 blocks (Kachaunna, Kothawan, Bahender, Sandila and Bharawan) of Hardoi district that are catered to under Sandila Chilling Plant. 145 members including dairy secretaries and key farmers participated in the review meeting covering agendas like – encouraging women participation in dairy associations, issues regarding milk quality, support required in dairy associations, documentation and dairy housekeeping, animal health, requirement of veterinary services etc.



# Wash

## E-Garbage Loaders Flag-off Ceremony

E-Garbage loaders' Flag-Off ceremony was held on 8th June 2023 at the District Magistrate's office in Hardoi, Uttar Pradesh.

Recognizing the issue of improper solid waste disposal in Urban Local Bodies (ULBs), as is major cause of littering and health problems, HCLFoundation initiated a way to strengthen solid waste management system in 8 ULBs of Hardoi district, through Door-to-Door waste collection, Source segregation and behavior change practices. HCLFoundation donated 8 E-Garbage loaders for safe collection and segregation of solid waste.

Shri Mangla Prasad (District Magistrate) and Mr. Alok Varma, Project Director, Samuday & My Clean City flagged off 8 E-Garbage loaders. Ms Priyanka Singh, ADM, Hardoi and Executive Officers of respective Nagar Palika were also present at the occasion.

This the second batch of the vehicles provided under the programme, after successful utilization of the 24 E-Garbage loaders deployed across 8 Urban Local Bodies since march 2022.





## Visit to Lokmata Rani Rashmoni Mission:

- HCLTech Grant visited Deulbari and Purba Gurguria villages of Kultali block of South 24 Parganas for the field monitoring visit of Lokmata Rani Rashmoni Mission, HCLTech Grant Finalists 2022 in the Environment Category. The programme participants have set up Nutritional Gardens in the backyard of their homes and are producing organic vegetables and selling the surplus.
- Poultry farming and goat rearing has been followed by the beneficiaries as the alternative source of income.
- One common facility centre has also been set up in which one rice mill and two other machines for the production of rice, chilli dust, turmeric dust, flour and more, have been procured with the support of HCLFoundation.
- Team also visited the in house laboratory that has been set up in one of the villages where farmers are preparing their own bio-fertilizers in their village and using it in their fields without spending additionally.

Utilization of 01-hectare underutilized land

80 farmers involved in 'No to Inorganic Agriculture (NIA)' using 5.7 hectares of land

Off which, 70+ individuals fulfilled the criteria and connected with the scheme free of charge. This is essentially an health insurance scheme backed by the government, and it aims to make insurance coverage more accessible and affordable to people from lower-income groups. Health benefits up to Rs. 5 lakh per family per year.

The virtual session was packed with knowledge about the fundamentals of social media accessibility and best practices of using assistive technologies and saw an impressive turnout of over 60 participants, including teachers from various schools, counselors, students, parents and HCLFoundation volunteers. The session explained about using Better Alt Text, the Use of Hashtags, Editing Alt Text on Facebook, Editing Alt Text after posting, Captions and Transcripts, Generating Auto Captions on Facebook Live, and Auto-generating Captions for Instagram Stories.

The virtual session was followed by an in-person workshop with students to create a tactile map of the layout of the different floors of the centre.



## International Day of Yoga

International Yoga Day was celebrated in an energizing way in two schools of Noida with the support of partner 'Bodh Shiksha Samiti', where both students and teachers practiced & performed sitting and standing asanas.



## Ayushman Bharat Scheme Linkage programme

Ayushman Bharat scheme linkage programme (which is health insurance scheme of GoI providing cover of Rs. 5 lakhs per family per year, for secondary and tertiary care hospitalization), has been rolled out in UDAY communities in Noida in collaboration with Doctors for You. The objective of the drive is to enroll 1 lakh Uday programme participants from the poor and marginalized communities over the course of 12 months.

**All winners were awarded with medals and cash prizes.**





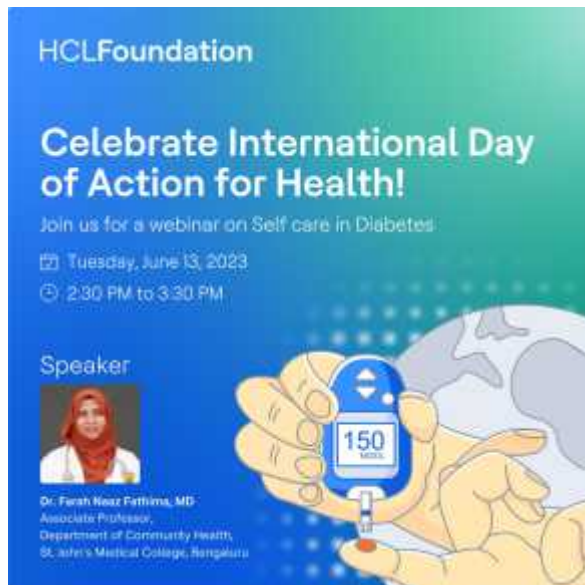
